

About Blagrave Recreation Ground

Blagrave Recreation Ground is land that was donated to the children of Tilehurst. It is held in trust by Reading Borough Council through a registered charity.

This pamphlet introduces an easy, circular walk round Blagrave Recreation Ground. The walk is accessible for pushchairs and buggies for the disabled and is particularly good for walkers with dogs. A gentle stroll around the path will take about a quarter of an hour.

There are seats and some lovely trees. However, it is known in particular for the two children's play areas which offer some nice play equipment.

This walk is part of a larger walk which is described on www.walkontheweb.org.uk which takes in the other parks, nature reserves and woodlands in Tilehurst.

How to get there

Walking

Easy distance from anywhere in Tilehurst. Make it part of a larger walk through our local parks - see www.walkontheweb.org.uk.

By bike

No motorbikes. Push bikes should not get in the way of walkers, but it is a really good, safe park for children to learn how to ride a bike.

By bus

There are bus stops in School Road and Corwen Road and in Tilehurst Triangle nearby.
