4	Chapel Hill ex allotments	Copse of hazel, rown, cherry birch blackthorn, hawthorn
5	Land off bran close	Small decorative eg whitebeam cherry roan
6	Land between Chichester and Norcot	Taller tress eg oaks sweet chestnut
7	Delaney Road near corner of Riley Road	Rowans
8	Norcot Road between Birch Ave and Lawrence	Small eg cherries rowans blackthorn hawthorn
9	Area on corner of Usk Road and New Lane Hill	Large trees and a smaller one and wildflowers
10	Land off Wedgewood Road and Chelsea Close	1 large tree eg oak and smaller eg rown cherry etc
11	Either side of junction Lower Elmstone Drive and	Smaller trees, light shade and wild flowers
12	Either side of junction Lower Elmstone Drive and	Smaller trees, light shade and wild flowers
13	Junction Pierces Hill and Westwood Road	Smaller trees light shade eg birch bulbs, wild flowers - bench
14	School Road outside post office	Small trees eg crabapples
15	Land along Co-op Walnut Way	Small trees eg crabapples
